Prix Littéraire Des Princes"at The Peninsula Paris



On 4th December, The Peninsula Paris partnered with the French magazine *Point de Vue* to host the very first edition of the “Prix Littéraire Des Princes”, a literacy prize, recognising through an exceptional evening, the best historical novel of the year.

This first “Prix Littéraire Des Princes”, created by *Point de Vue* in celebration of its 70th birthday, has brought together a jury exclusively made up of princes, princesses and VIPs, fascinated by history and literature including: the presenter Stéphane Bern, the actress and singer Arielle Dombasle, Prince Charles-Henri de Lobkowitz, Camilla Bourbon Princess of the Two Sicilies and her husband the Duke of Castro, the writer Adrien Goetz, the decorator Jacques Grange, the writer Tatiana de Rosnay, academician and writer Jean-Christophe Rufin, director of the Musée Galliera, Olivier Saillard, the architect Jean-Michel Wilmotte and Philippe Delorme, editorial manager of *Point de Vue Histoire* and actress Ines Sastre.

After intense deliberations, the prize of this first edition was awarded to Clara Dupont Monod for her novel “*Le roi disait que j’étais diable*”, bringing back to life the iconic figures of Aliénor d’Aquitaine and King Louis VII during the Middle Ages.

The lucky winner received with great emotion the award from Adelaide de Clermont-Tonnerre, chief editor of *Point de Vue*.
